**ORDER GRANTING WIFE'S SWORN EX PARTE
MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

This cause having come on to be heard upon the Wife's Sworn Ex Parte Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records, pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial administration 2.420(e), and the Court having reviewed the Sworn Motion, having reviewed the sworn pleadings in this file, and being otherwise advised in the premises, finds that it is

1. The motion is GRANTED.
2. This is an action for Dissolution of Marriage.
3. The particular grounds under subdivision 2.420(c) which provides for the records to be confidential are:
 - a. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(iv) – Confidentiality is required to obtain evidence to determine the legal issues in a case.
 - b. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(v) – Confidentiality is required to avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties.
 - c. 2.420(c)(9)(A)(vi) – Confidentiality is required to avoid substantial injury to a party by the disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in this type of proceeding.
7. The Court finds no less restrictive measure is available to protect these interests and that the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect those interests.

8. The Clerk of Court is hereby directed to seal immediately the following materials related to this matter and to keep such materials from public access:

a. The following documents within the court file:

i. The Wife's Financial Affidavit;

ii. The Wife's Sworn Ex Parte Motions and Orders for Immediate Temporary relief (Boulay and Interlachen) and (Safe Deposit Box) together with all exhibits attached thereto;

iii. Wife's Sworn Ex Parte Motion and Order to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records.

9. The persons who are permitted to view the confidential court records are: the Court, named parties, attorneys for named parties, and if necessary for work purposes, court staff, including hearing officers and magistrates, the Clerk of Court and Clerk's staff.

10. The Clerk is directed to publish this order, if required, in accordance with the requirements set forth in rule 2.420 of the Rules of Judicial Administration.
