**AGREED ORDER TO SEAL AND MAKE COURT RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL**

THIS CAUSE having come before this Court upon the *Husband's Verified Motion to Seal Parties' Court File*, and upon the agreement of the parties, and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises, the Court **FINDS** as follows:

1. This is an action for dissolution of marriage.
2. There are two (2) children born of the parties' marriage, to wit: Victoria Kingstone, born October 14, 1996, age thirteen (13) and Max Kingstone, born April 13, 1998, age twelve (12) (hereinafter collectively the "minor children").
3. Confidentiality is required to avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties and to avoid substantial injury to a party by disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in the specific type of proceeding sought to be closed. Specifically, confidentiality is required to protect the Husband's economic livelihood and the minor children's privacy and well-being.
4. It is not necessary for any party's name to be confidential.

5. The progress docket or similar records generated to document activity in the case are not to be made confidential.

6. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court is no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Fla. R. of Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A) and no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in Fla. R. of Jud. Admin. 2.420(c)(9)(A).


It is therefore **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** as follows:

4. The entire Court record in this matter is to be made confidential.

5. This Order shall in no way limit any party, the parties' counsel, or the Court from viewing the record referenced herein in furtherance of this matter.
